Project Review

Amcom Telecommunications contracted Expert Data Cabling (EDC) to perform a major fibre optic cabling project. The project was conducted over a period of six weeks from 01/09/2004 to 15/10/2004.

The project involved the installation of a large number of outdoor high count single mode fibre optic cables connecting various Amcom POP sites in Adelaide CBD buildings. This work included:

- Installation of outdoor single mode fibre optic cable
- Construction of outdoor fibre optic joints
- Termination of single mode fibre optic cable in Amcom POP sites
- OTDR and Insertion Loss Testing of single mode fibre optic cable
- Execution of fibre optic splicing activities during customer outages

The project schedule was very challenging with tight deadlines and many complicated and interdependent activities. EDC were extremely professional in the execution of the project scope. The work they performed met and exceeded industry standards in terms of quality and conformance to scope. EDC completed all activities in the project scope within the designated time frames.
